To the qualified Electors of the City of Rockwood, Wayne County, MI.:

**Please take Notice** that any qualified elector of the City of Rockwood who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State Branch office, or other designated state agency. The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is:

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Rockwood City Clerk's office, located at 32409 Fort Road, Rockwood, MI 48173

**PROPOSAL  
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT BOND PROPOSAL**

**Shall the City of Rockwood, Michigan, borrow the principal sum of not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000), payable in not to exceed twenty (20) years from the date of issue, and issue its unlimited tax general obligation bonds, in one or more series to pay the cost of sewage disposal system and wastewater treatment plant improvements, including a new holding tank, treatment plan upgrades and improvements and all related appurtenances and attachments? The estimated millage to be levied in 2020 is 1.45 mills (\$1.45 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and the estimated simple average annual millage rate to retire the bonds is 1.84 mills (\$1.84 per \$1,000 of taxable value.**
