CITY OF ROCKWOOD RHSA

On October 12, 2012, the Rockwood City Council established a Health Care Savings Plan with the Michigan Employees Retirement System (MERS) and approved the MERS Health Care Program.

The employees hired after July 1, 2012 shall not be entitled to retiree health care. Said employees shall be provided with Retiree Health Saving Account (RHSA) with an employer contribution of \$50.00 per pay period in to RHSA. The RHSA requires a 10 year vestment before eligibility for distribution.

Effective December 18, 2013 for the AFSCME Local 292 / Rockwood Clerical and DPW Employees
